In that role, she represented the United States in complex civil actions enforcing federal pollution statutes, including CERCLA, Clean Water Act, System Resource Protection Act (SURPA), and Clean Air Act, against individual, corporate, and state defendants. During her time with the Department, Katie led multiple case teams in litigation and negotiations, and, in 2024, represented the United States in a SURPA trial for environmental damages to the Virgin Islands National Park, *United States v. Ingrao et al.*, 3:19-cv-00096.
